Principal Function:

The organist/pianist provides music for the Sunday morning worship service.

The ideal candidate will be interested in playing every Sunday, but we also welcome candidates who are only available 1-2 Sundays per month. The hour-long service begins at 9am. The organist/pianist would be expected to arrive by 8:30am.

Qualifications:

- Sufficient keyboard ability to sight read hymns and other accompaniments.
- Experience in a church setting collaborating with staff, musicians, and volunteers.
- High school diploma or equivalent. Bachelor of Music degree is preferred.
- Knowledge of worship tradition to appropriately suggest music for worship.

Service Specifications:

Sunday service music typically includes a prelude, postlude, three hymns, doxology, and one additional piece to play during the offering. Music for the hymns and doxology are provided. Music selections for the prelude, postlude, and offering are typically 3-5 minutes long and are chosen by the musician. Occasionally, we may have special music during the offering, in which case the music would be provided and additional rehearsal time may be requested. We enjoy traditional hymns as well as more modern selections. We do not have a "praise band" or use pre-recorded backing tracks.

Weddings/Funerals:

The church musician has the first right of refusal for special services. Compensation is typically \$150, but may be negotiated with the client.
